In addition to being the first IFMGA guide from the Rai community, an indigenous group from eastern Nepal, he is the first Everest summiteer from the Thulung Rai community.

Mr. Rai has worked in the mountaineering and tourist industries for 13 years. Prior to becoming a mountain guide, he worked as a porter and then a trekking guide. He has conducted several excursions to 6,000- and 8,000-meter mountains. He led the Nepal Army's 2022 Everest expedition team as part of the government of Nepal's Mountain Clean-up Campaign.
